COBALTS W/ VOLVO ENGINE: (2018 & NEWER)

OLDER STERNDRIVES COBALTS W/ VOLVO ENGINE: (2017 & OLDER)

You can install a Engine Compartment Heater. This heater comes on automatically when it gets below 42 degrees.

(Does not work during power outages).

BE SURE TO KEEP STABILIZER IN YOUR GAS.

Ethanol blended gas will start to degrade in one month. It is always best to add a stabilizer such as 'Sta-bil', 'Biobor Ethanol Buster' or 'Yamalube'—all available at local stores.

^{*} Anytime you are running your engine, please make sure it is in the water.

MAKE SURE YOUR BOAT IS UP TO DATE WITH ITS SERVICE!

Giving your engine some love/preventive maintenance is one of the most important things with owning a boat—and sometimes one of the most overlooked.

- ALL NEW boats need to have their Initial 20/50-Hour Service to stay compliant with the engine warranties. You also want to make sure all is good after that 'break-in period'.
- Annual Service is also needed to stay compliant with engine warranties and keep engines protected. (OR every 100-hours if you are using the boat that much in a season/year).
- A happy, tuned-up, **winterized** boat will keep you and your family safe out in the water and save you money down the road with costly repairs.
